4. As the company's business activity falls within a single primary business segment viz. Manufacturing of ERW pipes, the disclosure requirement of Accounting Standard (Ind AS 108) on "Operating Segment" is not applicable.

Due to outbreak of COVID-19 which has been declared as a Pandemic by World Health Organization and subsequent lock down ordered by the Central and State Government(s) in India, the manufacturing facilities of the Company got affected. The Company in compliance with the necessary instructions/ guidelines, reduced its operations in a phased manner while ensuring health and safety of all the stakeholders. The Company is gradually ramping up its operations depending on the market conditions. The Company has adopted strict measures of social distancing, sanitization and process disruption in supply chain, etc. The management has exercised due care in concluding significant accounting judgements and estimates after taking into account possible impact of internal and external factors known to the management upto the date of these financial statements, to assess and finalise their carrying amount of assets and liabilities. Accordingly, as on date no material impact is anticipated in these financial statements. Further, the Company believes that this Pandemic may not have significant adverse impact on the long term operations and performance of the Company.
